### COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UP

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

### RIBBONS, AWARDS AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place dog in each jump height class. A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH and PAX ribbons will be awarded to any dog earning a MACH or PAX title. **All prizes, awards and ribbons must be picked up before the end of the show. No ribbons will be mailed.**

**Illegible entries will not be processed** and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

**Entries Close July 23, 2008 at 1130 pm** after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

**NO Fax, telephone** or e-mail entries will be accepted.

**A maximum of 10 entries** per envelope. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

**Entries sent by overnight mail** must be sent "no signature required." The Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for entries that remain undelivered or are delivered late because of signature requirements.

**Online vs Paper Entry Primary Limits:** SCAT is accepting online entries for this trial through the AKC Agility Online Entry Services. Go to [www.akc.org/AgilityEntry](http://www.akc.org/AgilityEntry) and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 40% Paper entries: 60%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

### MOVE-UPS:

All pre-show move ups must be received by 6 pm, Monday, August 3. There will be day to day move-ups at the show provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 30 minutes after the last class results have been posted. There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial.

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The **safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**SCAT will not be responsible** for the loss or damage to any dog entered and exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody and control of its owner or handler at all times.

It is **expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. SCAT and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. SCAT reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against SCAT or any official thereof.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

**Bitches in season** are not eligible to participate. (See refunds.) Bitches in season will not be allowed on show grounds.

**Pinch/prong and electrical collars** (dummy or not) or special training collars are not allowed anywhere on the trial grounds.

**Exhibitors should follow** their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

### REFUNDS

**Full Entry fees** will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date and time.

**Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund half of the entry fees per day for bitches unable to compete for this reason if the **Trial Secretary receives WRITTEN notice of withdrawal no later than 6pm, Monday, August 4, 2008.**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

**No entry fee** will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

**No entry fee** will be refunded if a dog is injured after closing date and time.

**No entry fee** will be refunded for amounts less than \$10.00.

### RINGSIDE

**Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

### MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

**A valid copy of a dog's jump height card can be sent with every entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class.**

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request whether or not they have sent a copy of such with their entry. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

### DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

### OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place outdoors on a grass surface. Ring size will be 100' x 100'.
